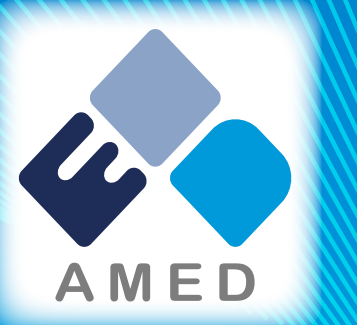




The e-ASIA Joint Research Program

3 years

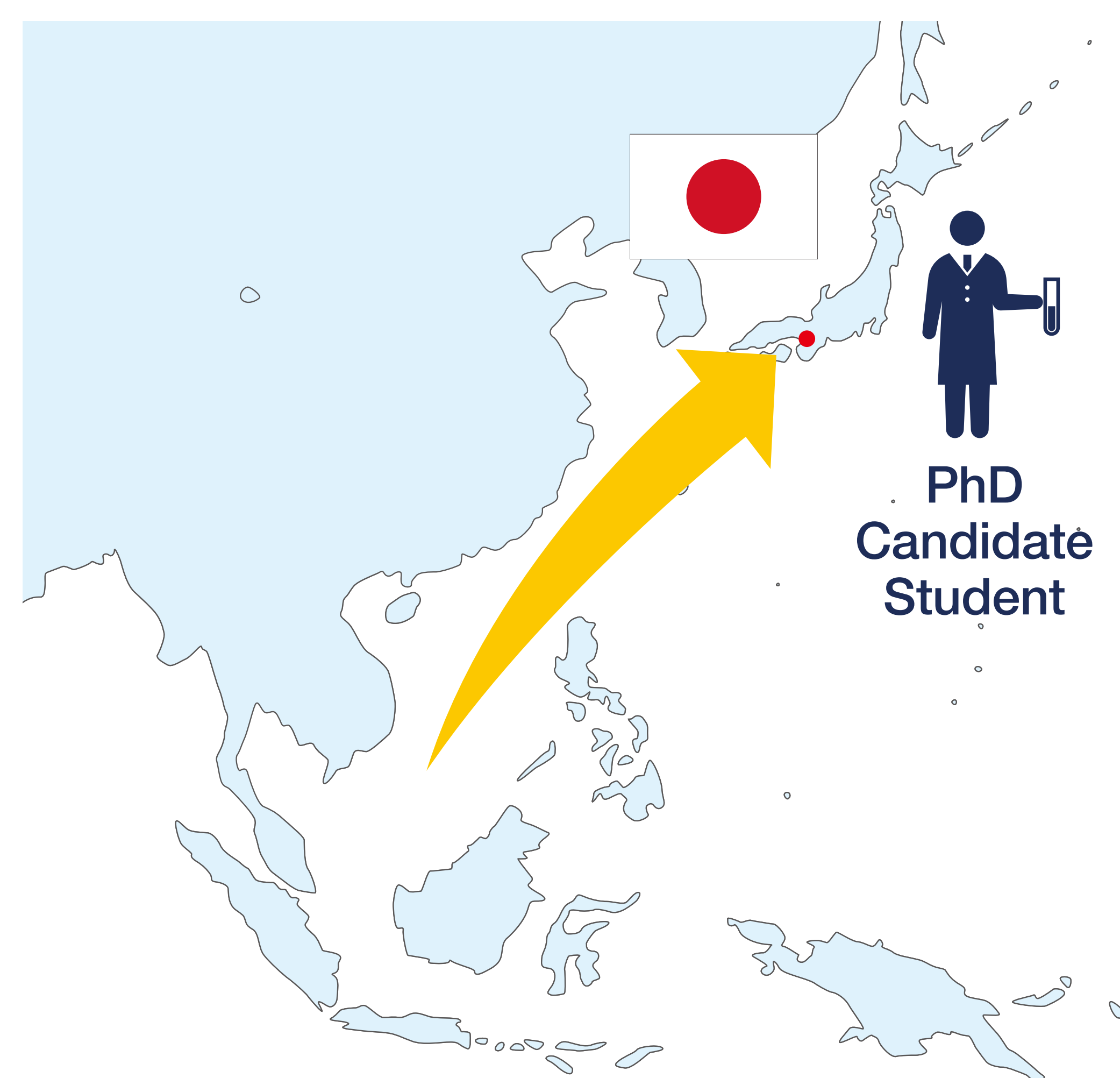
Special Scholarships for e-ASIA Projects

Supported by MEXT; Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan

To enroll in a PhD course at Japanese University and be engaged in research in the e-ASIA JRP project

Scholarship will cover

- Fees for the entrance examination, matriculation, and tuition at University
- Living expenses about 1,200 USD/month (145,000 JPY)
- Air fare to and from Japan at the beginning/end of the scholarship
